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Introduction

The Placement Cell (PC) was established in this Institute in September, 2016 with a vision to impart employability and entrepreneur skills to the undergraduate B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri. students that would enable them to set a best career goal. PC has set a target to achieve our Visionary Founder Arutselvar N. Mahalingam vision on imparting agriculture to rural aspirants and providing entrepreneurial skills to the graduates. To meet the vision, the PC sets following broad objectives:

- i. Focusing on development of the students to meet the Firms and Organisation recruitment process.
- ii. To encourage the students to develop technical knowledge and soft skills.
- To motivate the students aspiring to choose higher studies, competitive exams, mentoring and guiding them to excel in it.
- iv. To provide agro-based entrepreneurship skill development programmes periodically.
- v. Cent per cent placement to aspired students.

During the establishment period of the PC, the PC Officers reviewed several studies and visited to different institutes like Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, KCT, Coimbatore and IITs for strengthening KIA PC. PC Officers also discussed with several Agro-Firms to explore their expectations from the agriculture students during recruitments. 2. Nobel Vision

Nobel vision is an interesting initiative of KIA, focus to exposure of students on current updates, recent advancements in agriculture and allied sectors, renowned people in different platforms and policies, reforms, schemes and several breakthroughs that are useful for agriculture graduates. Lectures are conducted by KIA scientists on above topics for the exposure of students on every week Monday between 4.00 PM & 6.00 PM.



3. Study Circle

Study circle is a unique program which is specifically programmed for the grouping of students based on their field of interest. Through this program the students are mentored to form interest groups and discuss on various horizon of their interested subjects.

Usually, PC takes several steps to identify and collect data on student's field of interest (periodically) and provides motivation and assistances to form study circle consisting of students belonging to Third and Final years. Once groups are formed, PC supports in various ways like identifying mentors (Scientists) to each group for personalized assistance related to field of interest. Further each groups runs different discussions and mentors help in conducting subject oriented tests and other supports. This program is scheduled on evening hours of weekdays.



4. Coaching Classes

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Based on needs of the students, PC identified best performing institutes (based on last three years performs of those Institutes) for organising coaching classes on Higher studies, Competitive exams, Language exams and Job oriented entrance tests. Tie-up is done with the institutes and students are trained in those institutes with nominal charges. This program is done during their Third and Final year for interested students, helping them to crack the exams within single attempt after their completion of degree program. The classes organized till dates are as follows,

- Bank and CAT exams coaching classes have been arranged for the benefit of third and final year students by T.I.M.E Institute, Erode since from 01.12.2018.
- Coaching classes for competitive exams such as UPSC and TNPSC have been arranged for third year students by Sathya I.A.S Academy, Erode since from 22.02.2019.
- ICAR- JRF coaching classes are being conducted in the disciplines of Plant Science, Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry, Plant Pathology, Agronomy, Horticulture, Agricultural Entomology and Social Sciences from 01.02.2019 onwards. The classes are being conducted every Wednesday between 4 to 5 pm by our KIA Scientists.
- Counselling for higher studies both at national level and international level are being offered to students on weekly basis by Scientists of this Institute.
- Library working hours have been extended from 9.00 AM to 8.00 PM for the benefit of the final year students those who are preparing for ICAR-JRF exam.

5. Workshop

To enhance the students skill on communication (with focus on career development), aptitude and improving start-ups, PC is organising several workshops and trainings. For instance, a three-day Workshop on Soft Skills Development was conducted for the final year students for the batches of 2014-15 (February, 2018) and 2015-16 (January, 2019) and one week workshop on Soft Skills Development organised for 2016 to 2018 batches during eight semester. Students were trained on reasoning, quantitative aptitude, resume preparation, group discussion, personnel interview and communication skills.

PC organised a six days workshop on Soft Skills Development on 21-27, Apr.2022 with association of FACE Academy, Coimbatore. The workshop covered Team building, Group discussion, Personnel interview, Time management and so on. Students were trained on the following areas:

We invited Way Cool Food Products Ltd, Bengaluru for offering internship opportunities to our students on January 2022. Considering our request, Way Cool Food Products Ltd., was offered internship to four of 2018-19 batch students with a stipend of Rs. 8,000/month from 10th Feb.2022 to 31st Mar.2022.

9. Ideathon

An ideathon is a short, intensive, workshop-like experience for students to address some of the most pressing challenges of our time. To impart agripreneurship skill to the undergraduate students, PC had organised an Ideathon programme to focus on design thinking and innovative learning practices to ideate and collaborate on possible solutions.
